What is a Ballot Inspector?

- Ballot Inspectors (also known as Ballot Clerks) are community members just like you interested in maintaining the integrity of our elections! As a Ballot Inspector, you would serve in one of the many roles needed at the polls - marking the checklist, handing out ballots, helping voters in need at the ballot booths, receiving ballots at the box, and more. These positions are two year terms (starting in August 2020), serve for all state and local elections, and come with a small monetary stipend for your service.

What does the New Hampshire Democratic Party have to do with this process?

- Per New Hampshire state law, each political party is required to have a specific number of Ballot Inspectors in each town's polling locations (RSA 658:2). The number of Ballot Inspectors needed is determined by the NH Secretary of State.

Why is this important?

- In the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic, it is more important than ever before that we make sure every Granite Staters' right to vote is protected. Ballot Inspectors are the first people readily available to stand-up for voters at the polls on Election Day!

Is this opportunity for me?

- **YES!** If you are a registered voter and you have gotten far enough to read this one-pager, your interest in protecting people's right to vote is strong. We need great Democrats like you in your community's polling locations to advocate for voters' rights and help keep our elections secure.
